No. 5 of 2017**

**Robes not required for Chambers  
Applications in the High Court**

---

In order to avoid unnecessary inconsistencies in regular High Court proceedings I provide the following clarification.

In all chambers applications [since 2007 held in open court unless for cause] robes need not be worn. This modifies *Practice Direction No. 1 of 2010* at paragraph 5. Counsel will now dress as for the Magistrates Court.
